This year Wendy and her husband Craig will be out hosts. They have a beautiful backyard with lots of fruit trees and a huge garden.

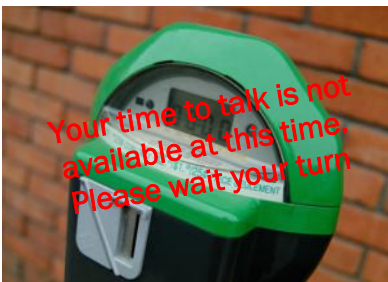
Let's hope for the continued beautiful weather and gorgeous evenings.
