GRANT CRITERIA

1. Schools eligible for grants include all public schools in Douglas County, grades Kindergarten through Junior High or Middle School (eighth or ninth grade depending on the school).
 2. Grants must be for projects that directly affect one or more students.
 3. Priority will be given to projects that promote ideas that are of special interest to Altrusa such as encouraging children to do community service, leadership training, vocational development, literacy, recycling, and the values of international and cultural diversity. *(The items listed are suggestions, and no project will be rejected simply because it doesn't fit specifically in one of these categories.)*
 4. Grant applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis and awards given throughout the year, as long as funds are available. Please allow six to eight weeks for grant applications to be processed.
 5. Grants will generally be awarded in amounts of \$100-\$500 but other amounts will be considered.
 6. If a grant is awarded, grantees will be expected to provide follow-up information either by a short (one page) written report **OR** by being our guest at a meeting and presenting an oral report.
