Answer each question as fully as possible. High school students should return this completed form to their high school counselor who is in charge of scholarships **no later than January 12, 2010.**

Top applicants will be selected for an interview with the Altrusa scholarship committee. The interviews will be held **only** on February 13, 2010.

Enclose 4 (four) collated copies of the following:

1. Application (no substitutions).
2. Your transcript showing your classes, grades, and class rank (available in your high school counseling center).
3. Your personal statement.
4. Your personal tax return – **Page 1 only** of form 1040 for the previous year and your parent's form 1040 for the previous year if you are claimed as a dependent.
5. Three letters of recommendation (one of which is to be from someone outside your school environment).

Do Not include a High School Portfolio or Resume.

The application will be disqualified, if:

1. Your signature does not appear on Page 5.
2. Your application is not complete and on official form. (No, **“See Attachment”**.)
3. A high school portfolio or resume' is included.
4. Any information is intentionally falsified.

The following criteria will be considered when making selections:

1. Application is complete, neat, and organized.
2. GPA (minimum accumulative GPA of 3.0), SAT, or ACT and applicant's goals.
3. Financial need.
4. Work experience.
5. School involvement.
6. Community involvement.
7. Personal statement.
8. Interview.
